



## VISITING MOLLYDOOKER

We would love you to visit us here at Mollydooker. We do informational tours which give you an explanation of what we do to get the intensity of colour and flavour and the silky tannins which are the hallmark of our wines.

Book to come on a Monday if you can, because then you can join us on our full tour. We don't charge for this as it our pleasure to welcome and look after members of the Mollydooker family. We recommend that you allow at least 3 hours for the visit. The tour starts at 10am and consists of:

1. a visit to the vineyard with an explanation of the Marquis Vineyard Watering Programme™
2. a walk through the winery with an explanation of our winemaking and barrel programmes, tasting the developing wines as we go,
3. a juice tasting with Sparky during vintage, to assess colour and flavour, Marquis Fruit Weight™ and potential harvest date, and
4. a light lunch with some of our current release wines.

If you can't come on a Monday, please get in contact with us as we may be able to give you a mini tour on another weekday.

We are governed by Occupational Health and Safety, Quarantine and Alcohol regulations. Please observe the following and make sure your guests know about them. They get MAD if they can't come on the tour and have to wait 2 hours for you.

1. a. Flat enclosed shoes, which have been thoroughly cleaned if you have visited any other vineyards. Sneakers are fine.  
b. Hat and sunglasses if it is a sunny day.  
c. Comfortable, safe clothing, appropriate for the weather.
2. Due to alcohol and safety regulations (and boredom!), tour participants **must be** at least 18 years old.
3. Transport:
  - a. We are approximately one hour south of Adelaide and 5km from McLaren Vale. A map with the directions on how to get here can be downloaded from our website.
  - b. You will be drinking wine and we want you to be safe. The legal driving limit is 0.05%. If you don't have a designated driver, you might like to book yourself a car and driver.
